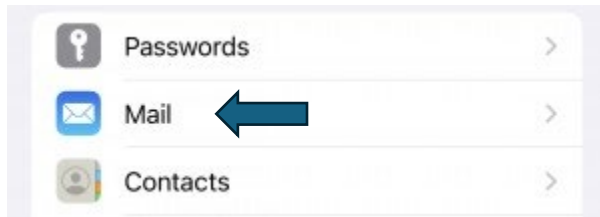


How to set up a POP or IMAP email account on iPhone

Step 1: Open Settings and scroll down to select **“Mail.”**



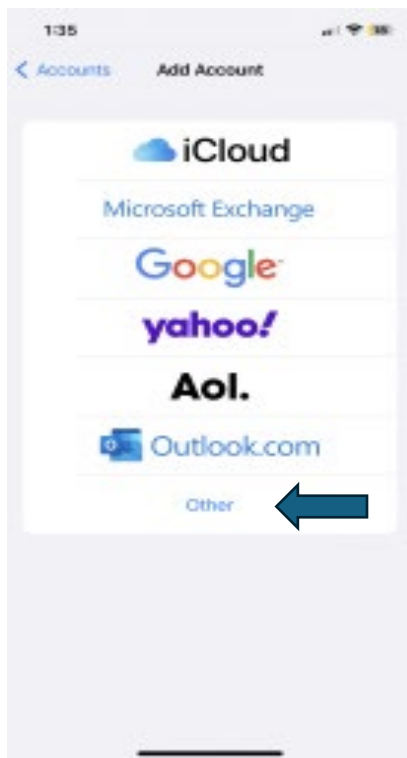
Step 2: select **“Accounts.”**



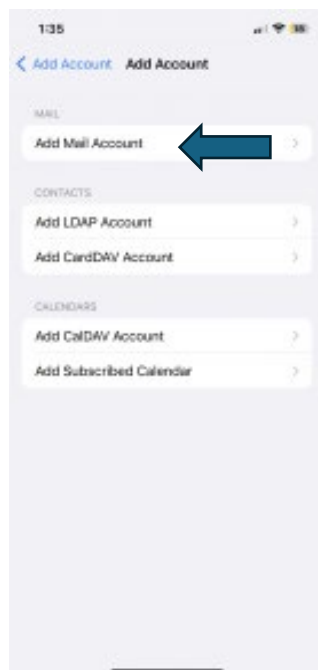
Step 3: select **“Add Account.”**



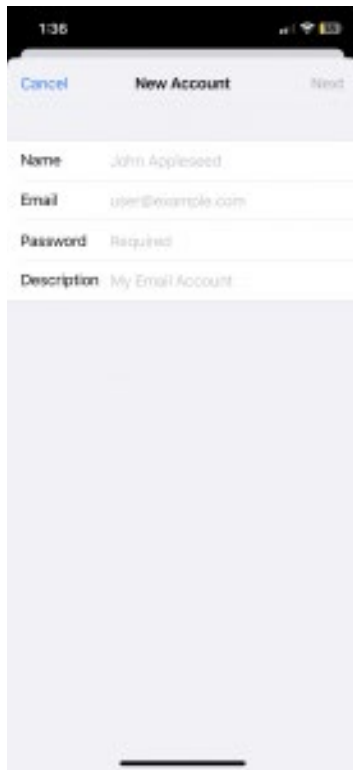
Step 4: You will see a list of mail accounts you can create on your device. You will want to select **“other.”**



Step 5: Under MAIL, select **“Add Mail Account”**.



Step 6: In the New account screen. Enter your name, full email address and password for the email account you are creating. The description field can be filled out as you see fit.

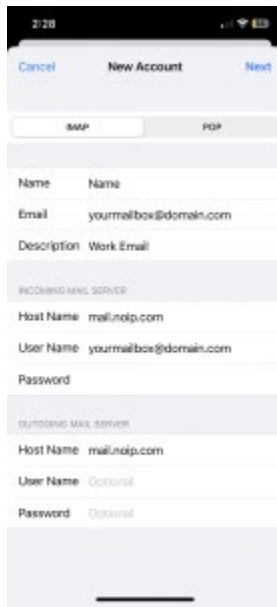

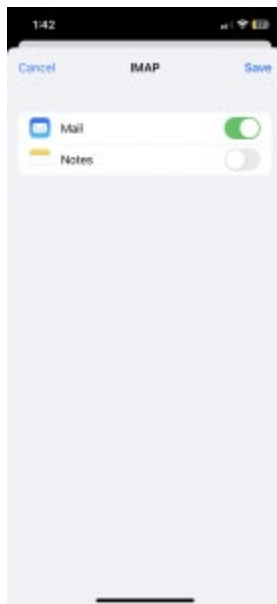
Step 7: After hitting **“Next”** you will need to enter our mail server information. You will have the option to select either IMAP or POP.

IMAP allows you to access your email wherever you are, from any device.

POP is designed to be used on only one computer. Enter your host name and for username enter your full email address.



Step 8: Once you hit **“Next”** it should verify the account and then give you options on what applications you can use with your mail protocol of choice.



Once you press save, you are all set! You successfully set up IMAP or POP on your iOS device.
